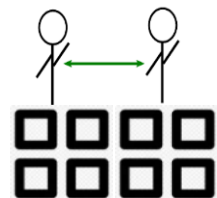
Health and safety at Pulse has always been our number one priority.



In light of COVID-19, we are strictly following all of the rules and regulations set forth by the Government of Ontario, York Region Public Health and Dance Safe Ontario, to do everything we can to reduce risk and prevent exposure.



Please review ALL of our protocols with your dancer before the start of your first class.

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FACILITY ENTRANCE RULES & PROCEDURES

WHO CAN ENTER OUR FACILITY:

Our lobby is temporarily closed due to capacity limits and rules and regulations in place therefore no parents or spectators are allowed entry in our facility.

- Only Dancers and Faculty will be permitted inside the studio. Mask is mandatory!
- Ages 2-5yrs “Boogie Babies” & “Kinder Kids”, MUST have one parent with them at all times who will accompany their child for the full duration of their class and stay within their child’s designated 6x6 / 10x10 or marked dance square/area (square size and social distancing rules subject to change throughout the season per York Region Public Health). The parent must notify Pulse by e-mail the full name of the parent accompanying their child and a three layered mask is mandatory.

MASKS (must be worn by all):

- Masks must be worn at all times inside the facility for all ages.
Exception: Ages 2-3years must arrive with a mask and try to dance with it, but if it becomes difficult while dancing, only this age group may remove their mask while in their designated dance square/area.
- Dancers are to pack an extra mask in case theirs becomes moist and needs to be changed.
- A fee of \$2.50 will be invoiced to you if we need to provide you with a disposable mask for any reason and/or for a ziplock bag for the dancer to store their moist mask in.
- If you have a medical condition that prevents you from wearing a mask inside our facility, you are at a much higher risk of getting seriously ill if you contract the virus and therefore although we understand you cannot wear a mask, we feel uncomfortable allowing you entry with the level of risk involved and welcome you back after the pandemic has passed.



ONLINE SELF-ASSESSMENT FORM, SCREENING, TEMPERATURE TAKING & HAND SANITIZING:

- Go to www.pulsedanceworks.com Covid-19 Protocols drop down menu, select “Self-Assessment Form”
- The Self-Assessment form is to be completed by each individual no earlier than 45 minutes before you arrive and no later than 10 minutes before the start of your class.
- If you need to leave and re-enter on the same day at a later time, you will need to complete the online form again.
- This form will be reviewed by our Staff prior to allowing you admittance into our facility and will be used for contact tracing. As well individuals will have their temperature checked at the door and MUST use Hand Sanitizer upon entering/exiting our facility.
- Individuals will NOT be allowed to enter the facility for any reason including if the form has not been completed, if “yes” has been answered to any of the questions, if an individual is showing signs of symptoms or has a fever.
- For your safety and the safety of all, Pulse Dance Works Inc. has the right to refuse entry.





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DROP OFF & ARRIVE “DANCE READY”



Please be on time, patient, understanding and respectful as we safely transition classes and conduct screening at the front door. NOTE: Pulse Dance Works Inc. does not manage the outside of our facility or complex. It is managed by The Monopoly Group.

DROP OFF INSTRUCTIONS:

- Dancers only are to be dropped off at our front entrance door no earlier than 10 minutes before their class time. Please be patient and practice social distancing, while waiting to enter our facility as we screen each individual. *****REVIEW our MANDATORY Screening procedures & Online Self-Assessment Form in order for dancers to be granted permission to enter our facility.**

ARRIVE “DANCE READY”:

- Arrive with mask on, hair done, in dance attire with your small labelled dance bag (containing only the shoes you will need for your classes) in hand to keep all personal belongings in. **Do NOT bring large dance bags.*
- **Have a separate leak free bag for outdoor shoes** to be placed inside your dance bag and/or in your specified bin inside your classroom. Shoes may be left on the shoe rack, but are subject to Lysol disinfectant spray so if you prefer your shoes to not be left on the shoe rack, please bring a “leak free bag” to have your outdoor shoes placed in your dance bin or dance bag.
- Pack an extra mask and a separate ziplock bag to place your moist mask in if you will be changing masks during class.
- Please use your personal washroom facility before arriving at the studio so we can quickly, smoothly and safely transition directly into the classroom.
- Upon entering, dancers must quickly remove their shoes, place them on the shoe rack or in their **“leak free” bag** and into their dance bag. Your dancer will be greeted and directed by Staff to follow the social distancing markings on the floor to safely enter their specified classroom, place their belongings in their specified bin inside the classroom and go to their assigned 6x6 dance square.



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PICK UP



Please be on time, patient, understanding and respectful as we safely transition classes and conduct screening at the front door. NOTE: Pulse Dance Works Inc. does not manage the outside of our facility or complex. It is managed by The Monopoly Group.

PICK UP INSTRUCTIONS:

- Classes may conclude 5-10 minutes early to allow for a smooth transition of classes, students exiting the facility and disinfecting of each classroom, and disinfecting of the dance floors for classes with different cohorts.
- 1 Parent is to PICK UP their dancer ON TIME, in person, outside the facility door (not from waiting inside your vehicle).
- Once you see your child at the door, give us a wave from outside and have your child inform us at the door they are with you so we know they have been safely picked up. If a child's parent is not there to meet their child we will have the dancer re-enter the facility and wait inside, however persistent tardiness will result in permanent transition to online classes without any fee adjustments, refunds or make up classes.
- Parents are to wear a mask and wait 6 feet from the entrance (you cannot enter the facility).
- Parents are to remain 6 feet apart from one another according to the yellow markings on the exterior wall by the Front Door windows. (*The outside of our facility is managed by Monopoly Property Management Group, not Pulse Dance Works Inc.*) If you have been instructed to pick up from our back door, then you may line up in front of our garage door to receive your dancer while practicing social distancing and wearing a mask. Do NOT block the back door nor park your vehicle in front of our garage door or in the middle of the roadway.
- Parents are to be patient and respectful while waiting to pick up their child and be prepared for all weather conditions, the same as if you were picking up your child from school.
- Parents who will be dropping off their child at the same time you would be picking up your other child, please arrive 5-10 minutes early to avoid congestion and to allow for social distancing and a QUICK and SAFE transition between classes.

IMPORTANT: We cannot escort, nor supervise your child to your vehicle or look for the parent waiting inside their vehicle. You **MUST** be responsible for the pick up and safety of your child at the Pulse facility door once your child's class has ended. This is for all ages!



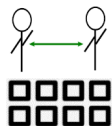
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IN-STUDIO AND DURING CLASS

- Limited class sizes and in accordance to the regulations put forth by our municipality to respect and follow physical distancing regulations.
- Our facility will be closed to all parents and spectators except for dancers 7yrs & under.
- Coat Room/Change Room is temporarily closed to all dancers.
- Personal belongings are to be placed in a small labelled dance bag and carried into the classroom in which each dancer will have an individual bin to place their belongings for the duration of their class. Have a separate leak free bag for outdoor shoes to be placed inside your dance bag and/or in your specified bin inside your classroom. Bins will be disinfected after each personal use.
- Classroom dance floors have clearly marked 6x6 and 10x10 dance squares for each individual dancer to dance in for the duration of their class (Pulse will advise dancers which size social distancing squares will be used in class based on York Region Public Health & Dance Safe Ontario). Older dancers who can safely practice social distancing may dance technical elements across the floor (ex. turns, jumps, tumbling) and possibly dance closer together while being masked. Ballet Barres will be marked every 6feet to ensure physical distancing at the barre, and will be frequently wiped down/disinfected.
- Dancers and Faculty must remained masked (three layer mask or two layer with a filter). Please remember to pack an extra mask if yours becomes moist and needs to be changed.
- Hand Sanitizer is stationed in our classrooms and throughout the facility. It will be frequently used by Pulse Faculty and Dancers will be encouraged to regularly use it as well in addition to entering/exiting the facility.
- Studio classrooms are equipped with tvs, webcams, laptops and/or tablets as classes may be livestreamed via Zoom for enrolled participants only (no spectators) enrolled in our online dance program or for dancers who cannot attend class in-studio due to Covid-19 symptoms.
- Hepa air purification systems installed in our facility.
- Studio classrooms are equipped with tvs, webcams, laptops and/or tablets as classes may be livestreamed via Zoom for enrolled participants only (no spectators) enrolled in our online dance program, or for dancers who cannot attend class in-studio due to Covid-19 symptoms.
- Pulse Faculty are vaccinated.



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CLEANING PROTOCOLS



- Pulse has added additional cleaning/sanitizing areas and procedures.
- Hepa air purification systems installed in our facility.
- High touch areas and hard surfaces such as bins for personal belongings, ballet barres, floors, door handles, light switches etc. will be disinfected in-between classes.
- Washrooms will be frequently sanitized throughout each day.
- Dance Floors will be disinfected with Canadian Government approved floor disinfectant spray “MBC 510” in between classes with different cohorts and as needed.
- As noted in your program information package, classes may conclude 5-10 minutes early to allow for a smooth transition of classes and disinfecting of each classroom including the studio floor.
- Our entire facility will be thoroughly sanitized following the final class of each day.
- All cleaning products are government approved.
- Pulse Faculty will be frequently washing/disinfecting hands and promoting proper hand hygiene. As well, Parents are expected to educate their child(ren) at home on how to properly wash/disinfect hands.
- Yoga Blocks, Therabands and other props will not be available for personal use to mitigate the spread of germs. Dancers registered in Technique, Pointe and Acrobatics will be asked to bring in their own.
